Mr. Barnholt has spent most of his career in the Food Retail and Supply-Chain business and was at the helm of KeHE from 2008 until the spring of 2023. During his tenure, KeHE grew tenfold from a regional specialty distributor with a single warehouse in Romeoville, IL, to a national food distribution leader with operations all over the U.S. and Canada.
